PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE

Introduction:

Dr. B.K.B. College established in 1967 has gradually emerged to a premier institution of higher education in a purely rural ambience. This centre for higher education came into being under the able leadership and guidance of several leading citizens of Puranigudam. It was, in fact, a very adventurous project to which all the people rich and poor contributed at their own strength. Dr. B.K.B. College owes a great deal to those dedicated souls trying every plan to realize a long-cherished dream. We take pride at their noble efforts.

The college is named after Dr. Birinchi Kumar Barua- a dedicated teacher, folklorist, research scholar and a renowned literateur of Assam who was born in the famous Kharangi Barua family of Puranigudam. The college offers two year higher secondary course under AHSEC in arts and three year degree course under Gauhati University in Arts. Now around one thousand students are enrolled in the institution. In addition to the seven full-fledged departments offering major course of studies the institution has introduced three new subjects e.g Sociology, Psychology and Performing Art (Sattriya Dance). Moreover our institution has applied to University Grant Commission for introducing some career oriented courses under Community College and B. Voc.

We take pride to announce that the institution has produced many worthy citizens since its inception. There is, however, no denying the fact that we are yet to fulfill some of the basic infrastructural and academic needs. Dr. B.K.B. College has successfully come through the national accreditation programme in September, 2004 initiated by the University Grant Commission (UGC) and was re-accredited by NAAC in January, 2011. The college celebrated its Silver Jubilee in the year 1993 and is preparing for Golden Jubilee celebration. The proposed year long Golden Jubilee celebration will commence on and from 30th July, 2016 with an inaugural programme on 18th August, 2016.

Location of the College:

Dr. B.K.B. College is situated in its own plot of land of more than six bighas alongside the National Highway 37. It is the only full-fledged college in Puranigudam, the erst-while sub-divisional head quarter during the British regime. The college campus maintains an excellent environment for teaching with evergreen trees, flower gardens and a fishery. The Kolong River at the back of the college building adds to its beauty.

Vision:

To impart higher education in under graduate (UG) level to the cross section of learners (basically belonging to the socio-economically backward communities) at an affordable cost through a syllabus designed by the parent university and a curriculum-extension interface at our own initiative.



Mission:

1. To generate knowledge and develop cognitive abilities through well planned curriculum, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities, teaching methods and evaluation procedure.
2. To inculcate values and preserve socio-cultural identities, ensure equal development and to foster a sense of belongingness to the Nation.
3. To create the academic environment for promotion of scholastic and non-scholastic activities.
4. To promote the values of self-sustenance and self-reliance by introducing career-oriented programmes, vocational workshops, seminars, etc. aiming at doing away with the legacy of bookish knowledge.
5. To realize social needs and arouse awareness among the students regarding emerging new realities, environmental and other challenges.

COURSES OFFERED

A. Higher Secondary Course of Study (ARTS) :

Core Subjects : English, MIL (Assamese, Alternative English), Environmental Studies.

Elective Subjects : Assamese Second Language (ASL), Economics, Education, History, Political Science and Geography.

Candidates wishing to offer MIL other than Assamese or Alt. English may do so after obtaining necessary permission from the H.S. Education Council. In this respect the candidate will be treated as institutional private and he/she is required to pay additional fee for this purpose as determined by the authority concerned.

Besides two core subjects a student is required to offer any three elective subjects listed above. A student may, if so desires, also take a fourth subject (but no credit mark shall be added from that).

B. Three-Year Degree Course (ARTS):

The college offers three-year degree course with major course of study in **English, Assamese, Economics, Education, Geography, History and Political Science**. The three year degree course is distributed into six semesters covering three calendar years w.e.f 2011-12. Before the onset of the scheduled semester-end examinations held in November-December and May-June respectively, the departments conduct sessional examinations. It is mandatory on the part of the students to appear in the **Sessional Examinations** conducted by the concerned departments **failing** which results of final semester examinations will be **withheld**. Thus students should note that it is essential to get assessed in the Sessional Examinations.

The students offering major in any of the seven subjects can take up any two of the following elective subjects: **Economics, Education, Geography, History, Assamese Second Language (ASL), Political Science, Sociology, Psychology and Performing Art (Sattriya Dance)**.

The students offering major in **English** are not allowed to study **Alternative English** and those who offer major in **Assamese** are not entitled to pursue **MIL (Assamese)**. They are to take up any one of the elective subjects.



C. Career Oriented Courses:

i) The College started a Career Oriented Course on 'Fashion, Textile and Interior Designing' under U.G.C scheme from the session 2007-08. This is a one-year certificate course. The H.S. qualified students are eligible to get admission in this course. The students can pursue this course side by side their normal course of studies. The students who are willing to take admission in this course have to pay Rs. 200/- as admission fee and Rs. 50/- per month as tuition fee.

ii) The following **Certificate/Diploma/Advanced Diploma Courses** are planned to be introduced shortly with financial assistance from U.G.C. under 12th plan –

1. Computer Hardware and Networking Maintenance
2. Beauty and Wellness
3. Horticulture
4. Theatre Studies

D. Certificate/Diploma Courses Offered under Institute of Distance and Open Learning (IDOL): MA in Assamese, MA in English, MA/M.Sc. in Economics, MA in History, MA in Political Science, MA/M.Sc. in Mathematics, M.Com., MA in Philosophy, MA in Bengali, MA in Bodo, Master in Communication & Journalism (MCJ), MA in Nepali, MA in Education, MA in Sanskrit

E. Courses under Krishna Kanta Handique State Open University (KKHSOU): Bachelor of Preparatory Programme (B.P.P), BA (Pass Course), BA (Major), Bachelor of Mass Communication (BMC), Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA), Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed).

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

For admission to H.S. and Degree Courses the students are to collect the admission form and prospectus in due time as announced by the authority and to submit the same along with the attested photocopies of mark sheets and other testimonials. Applications which are found incomplete or not submitted within specified date shall be cancelled. The students are required to be present on the day of admission and produce the original certificates.



All matters relating to admission are subject to the decision of the Admission Committee constituted by the college authority. Reservation of seats shall be maintained as per the Government Rules. Students having extracurricular proficiency and differently able students will get consideration in admission. Further, meritorious students securing 80% or above will get exempted from tuition fees.

Students opting for major in the subjects available will have to follow the instructions or norms framed by the concerned departments for finalization.

The department of Assamese has thirty seats for the major course while each of the other departments shall accommodate only twenty five students in the same.

MECHANISM FOR QUALITY ENHANCEMENT

Quality enhancement has been the top priority of higher education in these days. The U.G.C. has made it mandatory with appropriate guidelines to form an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in the colleges which is entrusted with the responsibility of monitoring the entire teaching learning process along with the steps taken for enhancement of faculty performance. IQAC has been active in our college since 2004 developing means and devices for a learner-centered

teaching mechanism. Thus, the academic interest of the cell is not restricted to the class-room deliberations alone; in fact it seeks to ensure coordination and interface between the details of scholastic and non-scholastic activities. Some of the healthy practices introduced by the IQAC in our college may be mentioned as follows –

- a) Continuous evaluation of the teachers' performance.
- b) Maintenance of day to day performance record.
- c) Preparation of teaching plans before the onset of academic sessions
- d) Tutorial groupings of the students under the direct supervision of one or two teachers for intimate, individual counseling. Any urgent matters that are found to be causing hindrances to the academic growth of the learner concerned are brought to the notice of the authority for amicable settlement.
- e) Coverage of the course within stipulated time frame is a must. In case of any lapses the concerned faculty has to take some extra classes for maintaining the gap.

FACILITIES AVAILABLE IN THE COLLEGE

Hostel:

The college provides hostel facilities for girl students with provision for twenty two inmates. The students belonging to tea-tribe communities shall get preference. Intending students may apply for hostel seats in prescribed form issued by the office during admission. While admitting students to the hostel the concerned committee takes final decision and will be selected for admission in the college hostel on the basis of merit and distance.

Conveyance Allowance for Students:

The college has been providing Conveyance Allowance under U.G.C. scheme to students who hail from places 10 kilometers (or above) away from the college. The beneficiaries under this scheme must have a fair record of class attendance. No conveyance allowance will be provided during vacation/leave/recess which exceeds one week. There is a committee assigned for this purpose to finalise the matter.

Corpus Fund:

Corpus Fund, formed with monthly contributions of teaching and non-teaching staff of the College, is meant to provide financial assistance to the students belonging to the economically disadvantaged families requiring assistance for medical treatment and academic pursuit. However, the sole responsibility lies with the committee to consider the cases of the beneficiaries and the amount to be sanctioned thereafter.



Poor Fund:

The college has been providing financial assistance to students belonging to economically disadvantaged families from the accumulated fees collected from the students at the time of admission. The office after collecting the forms from the students in the month of November-December submits the same to the Poor Fund committee for selecting the beneficiaries on merit cum means basis.



Central Library:

The college library is enriched with more than fourteen thousand volumes of texts and reference books of eminent authors. The reference books of various kinds have definitely improved the quality of the library. National and regional newspapers, journals & periodicals are available for the use of the students along with a spacious reading room. There is perhaps no limit to the standard of a well-managed library and hence we are still trying to improve and modernize the library. Books are issued to the students having library card from 10 A.M. to 3 P.M. A student

can borrow two books at a time, for a fixed period of 15 days. After that the same books may be reissued. The college has a librarian, two assistants and a bearer. In case of any damage or loss of the book(s) borrowed the students are liable to bear the cost or purchase the same to return to the library.

Book Bank:

There is also a Book Bank especially for the poor students in order to provide text books for the entire session. On receiving application a panel of selectors will consider the eligibility criteria and then finalize the list of beneficiaries. We have plans to reshape and augment the existing Book Bank.

Departmental Library:

Each department of Dr. B.K.B. College maintains a small library with facilities of providing books particularly to the students offering major. There are around two hundred to five hundred books including journals in each of such libraries and it has been of great help to the advanced learners.



College Canteen:

All the members of the college community can avail the facility of the canteen installed within its campus. It provides lunch, tea and snacks at a comparatively low price with the supply of pure drinking water. Plans have been submitted for construction of a well-furnished canteen with modern facilities.



Auditorium:

'Sudhakantha Dr. Bhupen Hazarika Prekshagriha', the auditorium of the college is constructed with financial assistance from Tea Board, India and formally dedicated to the service of the academic community in 2013. Since then the auditorium has been in use while conducting various academic and community oriented programmes such as Freshers' Social, meetings, seminars, workshops, etc. An auditorium complete in itself is an expensive project and still needs further works for completion.

College Gymkhana:

The college has a well equipped Gymkhana for physical exercise and body building for the students and youths of the locality. A well trained physical instructor gives necessary training and instruction. The monthly fees for the students of the college is Rs. 50/- and for outside members it is Rs. 100/-.

Scholarship:

All the schemes of scholarship facilities offered by the governments and other agencies are made available to students belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, OBC, MOBC and Minorities. The students must have at least 70% attendance to avail the scholarships.



Besides, The institution offers “Prof. N.P. Mahanty Memorial Merit Award” sponsored by Mamoni Saikia Mahanty, the former Associate Professor of Dr. B K B College. The award is offered to the meritorious student securing the highest marks in major/general subject in Final Examination with a cash amount of Rs. 2000/-. Gayatri Gope, Associate Prof. Department of English offers Rs. 1000/- to the Best Singer of the College every year.

Other Facilities:

1. The college provides facilities for involvement in sports, N.S.S., N.C.C, Scouts and Guide, cultural programmes, symposium, workshop - vocational & general. Some special UGC sponsored programmes like Remedial Coaching for slow learners and Entry into Service for preparing the students aspiring for employment, Career Counseling and Guidance etc are periodically arranged.



Wi fi connected Internet facility will be available in the college campus which will be the next bold step towards IT connectivity.

2. Adoption of Barchungjhar (at Chapanala) as a model village has been a long-term effort at extending community service to the disadvantaged social groups. The college has already introduced several programmes of free health check-up and vocational training in collaboration with the state departments.
3. The UGC Resource Center imparts basic instruction on computer application and use of e-resources to the students.
4. The Blue Ribbon Club organizes AIDS awareness programme and Blood Donation camp in collaboration with the office of the joint Director of health, Nagaon.
5. The NCC unit of Dr. B.K.B. College has had a fair record of participating in various camps and events organized by the concerned department and also getting involved in smooth conduct of different academic and sports activities performed by the college. This year Dr. B.K.B. College hoisted the state level NCC camp with active participation of our cadets in various cultural and sports activities.
6. Dr. B.K.B. College has launched its own website www.bkbcollege.in with vital information concerning our scholastic and non-scholastic activities, plans and programmes, national accreditation by NAAC, details of faculty, courses of study etc.

7. Our college has got qualified to receive grants under RUSA for development of infrastructure and works to this effect are in progress.
8. An **Arya Bhatta Science Centre** was established in the year 2009 in the college campus in association with Dristi Foundation under Ministry of Science and Technology to popularize science and to foster scientific attitude amongst the learners.
9. Talented students having proficiency in cultural and sports events are generally given incentive to participate in events organized in the university and other colleges. It is a matter of pride for us that on many such occasions our students have been able to secure positions.
10. Dr. B K B College has so far organized two mega events sponsored by the parent University. One is the **Inter College Volleyball competition** held in 2008 and the other is the recent event of **Inter College Badminton Competition** held in February, 2015.
11. Dr. B K B College periodically organizes Book Fair for the benefit of the students and the people of the local society. We normally invite some reputed publishers cum distributors like **Satirtha, Anwasha and Ank Bnak**.

While introducing these schemes we mostly keep in mind the regional needs, all-round development of the students. With such involvement we want our students to be familiarized with the contemporary socio-economic realities. The institution seeks to provide them with a platform where each student can at least realize the old values and new compulsions, find basic instructions to procure a means of livelihood. Arousing individual sense of responsibility towards preserving healthy environment and national integrity is among our top priorities.

Almost all required facilities and equipments are now made available in the departmental laboratories of Education and Geography. Proposals are submitted to the U.G.C. demanding allocation during the 12th five year plan for modernization of the same. The GIS facility has already been introduced to the laboratory of Geography.



EVENTS AND DAYS CELEBRATED

Foundation Day:

Dr. Birinchi Kumar Barooah College was established on 30th July, 1967 and the Foundation day of the college is celebrated on the same day every year.

Dr. Birinchi Kumar Barua Memorial Lecture:

16th October is the date of birth of Dr. Birinchi Kumar Barua, the renowned educationist, literateur and a pioneering folklorist hailing from this region. It is a tribute to this illustrious son of the soil to christen the institution after his name.

The Governing Body of the College resolved to institute a Memorial Lecture in his name on his date of birth on 16th October each year. The maiden memorial lecture was held on 16th October, 2006 in the college premises and Dr. Nagen Saikia, ex-president of Asom Sahitya Sabha and a great litterateur of Assam delivered the lecture on Assamese society and culture with reference to B. K. Barua's works. On 16th October, 2008 Sangeet Natak Academy award winner Sri Ghana Kanta Bora Borbayan delivered the next memorial lecture on the Sattriya Dance Form followed by another lecture delivered by Dr. Rita Choudhury, Sahitya Academy Award winner Novelist on 23rd November, 2012. Dr. Mallika Kandali delivered the lecture on 'Sattriya Nrityat Sastriya aru Lokasanskritik Upadan' on 10.11.2014 with performance on the dance form. The last memorial lecture was organized on the theme historical, literary and cultural aspects of Dr. B.K. Barua's scholarship. Mr. Lakshminath Tamuly, Dr. Madan Sarma and Dr. Sunil Kr. Datta were invited to deliberate on the issue.

Fresher's Social:

The new batch of students is given a formal welcome in the month of September every year with a two day programme. A general meeting is held on the first day and academic and cultural personalities are invited to address the new batch of students aspiring higher pursuit of knowledge. The second day is marked with cultural programmes performed by the students.



The College Week:

It is the largest event celebrated in the college normally in the first week of February. It begins with the hoisting of the flag, various sports, cultural, literary events and ends with a prize giving ceremony. A colourful cultural procession showcasing the diverse cultural and ethnic items remains the most fascinating moment of the college week.

Besides these, the college community celebrates the Independence Day, the Republic Day, Saraswati Puja, the Tithi of Sankardeva, Fateha E Dowaj Daham, Gandhi Jayanti, World Environment Day, Women's Day, Children's Day etc.



DISTRICT LEVEL TALENT SEARCH EXAMINATION

The college has been organizing a District Level Talent Search Examination every year for the students of Class IX and Class X of our feeding centres. From the current session the Talent Search Examination will be introduced in the memory of late Swamalata Gayan and the candidates securing the 1st, 2nd and 3rd position will be awarded Rupees 2500/-, 2000/- and 1500/- respectively. The prize money will be offered by one of our alumni Mrs. Marami Gayan, Associate Professor, Nowgong Girls' College.

COLLEGE UNIFORM

The students are required to wear the college uniform while attending their classes and the functions.

For Boys : White Shirt & Black Pant (Formal), Navy Blue Sweater.

For Girls : Muga Coloured Mekhela, Chadar with Blue Borders &

White Blouse, Navy Blue Sweater. Or

White Salwar-Kurta with Navy Blue Chunni, Navy Blue Sweater.

CLASS ATTENDANCE

70% attendance is compulsory for the students of H.S. and degree classes. With any record of attending less than 70% attendance, a student will be declared non-collegiate and in case the attendance falls below 60% he/she will be dis-collegiated. The non-collegiate students will have to pay a fine as fixed by the university while the discollegiate ones shall be debarred from attending the semester-end examinations.

IDENTITY CARD

All the newly admitted students are provided the college identity card. The card needs to be duly filled up and attached with a passport size photograph signed by the Principal of the college. At any time while being present in the college the principal or a teacher is entitled to claim the identity card. In case of missing or getting damaged, a student is required to inform the authority through application and must get it reissued within a month with a fine of Rs.20. Only the identity card holders can contest in the general election of the student's union and claim scholarship.
