Student Satisfaction Survey Report, Session: 2020-21

## Introduction:

The students are always considered as the core stakeholders of any academic institution and all the activities undertaken and the facilities provided by the institute are focused on creating a conducive and barrier free environment for them so that they can excel in their academics. Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) is one of the mandatory criteria prescribed by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in order to measure the student satisfaction level on students' experiences with college facilities. The Student Satisfaction Survey basically highlights on Teaching Learning Evaluation. It collects in-depth information of a student's satisfaction with the teaching learning environment of the college with the help of a well structured questionnaire. The responses given by the students are collected, processed, analyzed and presented in graphs to have a vivid idea about the level of satisfaction of the students which helps in streamlining the services offered to the students. The results of the survey summarize the expectations of the students and experts educationalists and the extent to which the College was able to meet these expectations.

## Methodology:

The student satisfaction survey of Dr. B.K.B. College, Puranigudam was conducted and reported by Internal Quality Assessment Cell (IQAC) of the college with support of Heads of all the departments and Coordinators of different cells of the college. The well structured questioner including all the dimensions was prepared in the form of Google form and circulated randomly among the students with the help of the coordinators of different cells and HODs of the departments. Each question in the SSS format is aimed at collecting factual opinion of students on teaching learning and evaluation process including aspects of curriculum, completion of syllabus, attitude of teachers, transparency and fairness in internal evaluations, curricular and extra-curricular activities, overall impression and suggestions about the college. The results of the survey will help the institution to understand both short term and long term needs of the students and initiate remedial action to improve the facilities. The outcome of this survey will provide a base for planning for the future.

## Analysis and the findings:

The responses collected from 165 sample students were fed to an excel sheet designed for the analysis of the information by the team. The responses were processed analyzed and presented by a team of faculties. Before proceeding for the survey, the basic information of the students including Gender, Caste, Religion etc. were collected.

## Key findings from the survey

1. A high percentage of students ( $64.24 \%$ ) confirm the completion of $85 \%$ to $100 \%$ of syllabus in our college. Again 22.42 \% students reported that $70 \%$ to $80 \%$ of syllabus was covered.
2. Students have expressed overall satisfaction regarding the teachers' preparation, teachers' ability to communicate and teachers' approach to teaching.
3. Students have also appreciated the teachers' attitude towards teaching, fairness in evaluation and teachers involvement in the performance of the students' assignments.
4. A very high percentage of students confirm that the institution takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, and field visit opportunities for students.
5. Avery high percentage of students reported that the teaching and mentoring process in the institution facilitates them in cognitive, social and emotional growth. Again, $46.67 \%$ students strongly agreed and $43.03 \%$ agreed that the institution provide them multiple opportunities to grow and learn.
6. A high percentage of students reported that the teachers identify their strengths and encourage them with providing right level of challenges. Again teachers are also able to identify their weaknesses and help them to overcome them.
7. $44.85 \%$ students strongly agreed and $42.43 \%$ students agreed that the institution makes effort to engage them in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process. Again a good number of students reported that the institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning.
8. The college provides ample opportunities for extracurricular activities like cultural activities and sports activities. The students have opined that college also provides opportunities for development of soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work. The students have expressed satisfaction regarding the mentorship programme, skill development programme run by the college.
9. Students also appreciated the use of ICT in teaching and regular organization of online classes during the lockdown period which were highly fruitful for them as reported. Again a very high percentage of students have confirmed that the teachers assigned them home work/assignment/open book examination during the period of online classes. However, a huge section of the students reported the poor network problem faced by them during the online classes.
10. The students have expressed overall satisfaction regarding the arrangement of orientation programme on open text book examination.
11. Regarding the infrastructural facilities $32.12 \%$ students reported excellent on toilet facilities and water supply facilities. They also expressed overall satisfaction regarding the canteen facilities also.

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
